

FOOD IS ENERGY

Food security begins long before the farm gate. Modern agriculture depends on oil and natural gas to produce sulfur, ammonia, and the fertilizers that determine crop yields. Those yields influence livestock feed costs, while processing, refrigeration, rail, trucking, and shipping carry those costs through the rest of the food system. Every link in the chain runs on energy.

When a strategic waterway is disrupted, an adversary restricts exports, or domestic capacity proves too concentrated, the effects do not appear immediately at the grocery register. They move through seasonal fertilizer purchases, planting decisions, livestock cycles, transportation costs, and infrastructure constraints. A falling gasoline price therefore does not guarantee lower food prices, and a temporary reopening of a shipping lane does not eliminate the underlying vulnerability. Food is increasingly part of the economic battlespace, where control of energy, industrial processing, logistics, and critical inputs can create leverage over nations and households. These conditions must be understood, anticipated, and planned around rather than treated as isolated crises that will simply pass.

Food prices are shaped long before products reach the supermarket. Oil, natural gas, fertilizer production, refrigeration, transportation, and global shipping all influence what families ultimately pay at the register.

» **Overseas disruptions eventually reach American households.**

A closure or slowdown in the Strait of Hormuz, a fertilizer export restriction, or a surge in shipping and insurance costs lands first on producers. Months or even years later, those pressures can appear through reduced crop yields, higher livestock-feed costs, and more expensive food.

» **Supply-chain shocks operate on delayed timelines.**

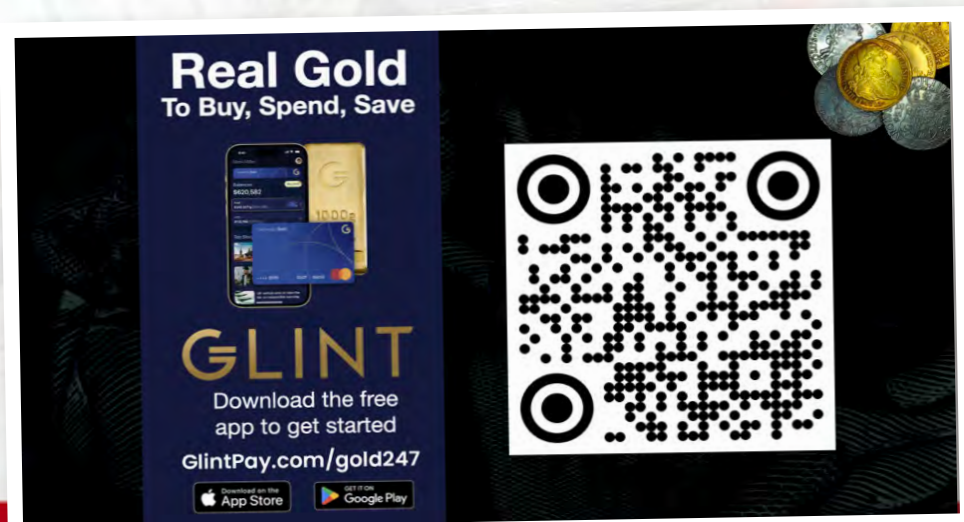
Fertilizer is purchased seasonally, crops require time to grow, and cattle herds take years to rebuild. Understanding these lags allows households, businesses, investors, and policymakers to prepare before today's disruption becomes tomorrow's food bill.

» **America has created vulnerabilities of its own.**

Heavy dependence on imported potash, concentration within domestic fertilizer markets, aging infrastructure, and regulatory barriers create single points of failure even without hostile foreign action. Efficiency without redundancy can leave essential systems unable to absorb shocks.

» **Preparation preserves freedom of action.**

A rotating food reserve, relationships with local producers, backup plans for water and power, diversified supply chains, and disciplined investment analysis create practical options. Preparation is not panic; it is the margin that allows individuals and nations to make deliberate decisions under pressure.

1. Food as a Battlespace: How Energy, Fertilizer, and the Strait of Hormuz Drive Food Security and Grocery Prices

Food production is fundamentally an energy system. Long before food reaches a farm, processing plant, or grocery store, it begins with crude oil and natural gas.

The chain has two primary branches. In the first, oil and natural gas refining produces elemental sulfur as a byproduct. That sulfur becomes sulfuric acid, which is used to convert phosphate rock into phosphoric acid for phosphate fertilizers such as DAP and MAP. In the second, natural gas is converted into ammonia and then into urea, the world's most widely used nitrogen fertilizer. Natural gas is not a minor input in this process; it accounts for most of the cost of producing ammonia.

These fertilizers determine crop yields. Crop yields determine the cost of livestock feed. Feed costs influence the price of beef, pork, poultry, and dairy products. After harvest, food must still be processed, refrigerated, stored, and transported by truck, rail, barge, or ship. Every link depends on energy.

This explains why lower gasoline prices do not immediately produce lower grocery bills. Each part of the food system operates on a different timeline. Diesel costs can change quickly, but fertilizer is purchased months before planting. Crops require a full growing season. Cattle herds take years to rebuild. An energy or shipping shock therefore moves through the food system slowly, appearing at the grocery register long after the original disruption has faded from the headlines.

The Strait of Hormuz concentrates many of these risks in one narrow waterway. A strategic chokepoint is a geographic or logistical passage through which a significant share of essential trade must move. At only 33 miles wide at its narrowest point, the Strait carries roughly one-third of the world's seaborne fertilizer trade, including about 40 percent of globally traded urea and 44 percent of seaborne sulfur.



When shipping through the Strait is interrupted—or merely becomes too dangerous or expensive—fertilizer markets react quickly. Urea prices can surge, sulfur supplies tighten, shipping insurance rises, and producers reduce output because they cannot secure affordable inputs. Commercial traffic may continue in technical terms while operating at only a fraction of normal levels. The decisive question is not simply whether a loaded vessel can leave the region, but whether shipowners are willing to send empty vessels back into contested waters.

That uncertainty becomes a cost of its own. Insurers raise premiums. Carriers reroute ships. Businesses delay commitments. Farmers face higher fertilizer bills during fixed seasonal purchasing windows, often without the ability to pass those costs along. The consequences then move down the chain into planting decisions, livestock production, and household food budgets. Across 2026 this played out as a round trip and then a reversal: world urea ran from roughly \$400 a metric ton toward \$850 by April, fell back near \$453 in June when a peace deal briefly reopened the lane, then climbed again within days when the strikes resumed. Spike, collapse, spike again—which is precisely why this is a condition to be managed rather than a crisis to be waited out.

The effects are already visible in the pressures facing farmers and consumers. More than 70 percent of surveyed farmers reported that they could not afford all the fertilizer needed for the coming crop. At the same time, the American cattle herd has fallen to its smallest level in 75 years, while ground chuck has reached record prices. These problems cannot be reversed by a single policy announcement or a temporary decline in commodity prices. Fertilizer shocks affect future harvests, and rebuilding livestock capacity requires years.

Food security must therefore be understood as more than an agricultural issue. It depends on reliable energy, accessible fertilizer, secure shipping lanes, functioning infrastructure, and sufficient capacity throughout the supply chain. Once those dependencies are visible, the next question is unavoidable: who controls the critical inputs and processing capacity upon which that system depends?



Attention: Energy and fertilizer chokepoints transform food from a domestic agricultural concern into a strategic battlespace whose disruptions can shape household budgets for years.

2. Strategic Supply Chain Warfare: China’s Fertilizer Leverage, America’s Domestic Vulnerabilities, and the Need for Greater Resilience

The previous section demonstrated that modern food security depends on energy, fertilizer, and global transportation. The next question is equally important: who controls those critical inputs? Increasingly, the answer determines who holds strategic leverage.

China has spent decades building dominance not by owning the world’s resources, but by controlling the industrial capacity needed to process them. This distinction matters. While China possesses only about five percent of global phosphate reserves, it has accounted for more than 40 percent of global phosphate production through sustained investment, government support, and refining capacity. In strategic competition, processing dominance can be more valuable than resource ownership.

That advantage becomes particularly powerful during periods of market stress. Rather than increasing exports when fertilizer supplies tightened, China restricted shipments of nitrogen fertilizers, potassium blends, certain phosphate products, and sulfuric acid—the very chemical required to convert phosphate rock into usable fertilizer. Restricting both the finished product and one of its essential processing inputs magnifies leverage across the entire agricultural supply chain.

This reflects a broader pattern that has emerged across multiple strategic industries. The same playbook has been used with rare earth elements, gallium, germanium, and other critical materials: build processing dominance, become indispensable to global markets, and then use supply restrictions as a tool of economic influence.

America, however, faces more than foreign vulnerabilities. It has also created significant domestic ones.

More than 90 percent of U.S. potash consumption is imported, with the overwhelming majority coming from a single allied nation. Potash—alongside nitrogen and phosphate—is one of the three essential nutrients required for modern crop production. While Canada remains a trusted partner, dependence on any single supplier for a strategic input reduces resilience should trade routes, production, or geopolitical relationships change.

Domestic market concentration presents an additional challenge. Four companies control roughly three-quarters of America’s nitrogen fertilizer production, while only a handful dominate other key agricultural inputs. Decades of consolidation reduced costs during stable periods but also reduced redundancy, leaving fewer alternatives when disruptions occur. Even sulfur presents a strategic dilemma. The United States produces much of what it needs, yet significant quantities are exported into markets that may later restrict

the finished fertilizer products American farmers require. What is genuinely new in this phase is that the waterway itself is being eyed as a revenue instrument: Iran has worked to push commercial vessels onto routes it controls and collect passage fees, while U.S. officials have floated “guarding” the strait and being reimbursed for it, including a briefly discussed toll on Hormuz shipping. A sea lane converted into a toll booth is one more price set by someone else on the American dinner table.

The lesson extends beyond fertilizer. Whether examining concentrated agricultural processing, critical mineral refining, or even food distribution itself, the same principle applies: systems optimized exclusively for efficiency often sacrifice the redundancy needed to withstand disruption. Concentration may lower costs during normal conditions, but it also creates attack surfaces that require little effort to exploit. The largest foodborne illness outbreak linked to a single lettuce source illustrates that not every vulnerability requires malicious intent—some simply emerge because too much capacity depends on too few suppliers.



Building resilience therefore requires more than responding to individual crises. It requires strengthening domestic refining capacity, diversifying supply chains among reliable allies, modernizing transportation and industrial infrastructure, reducing unnecessary permitting delays, and avoiding excessive dependence on any single supplier or processing hub. Economic resilience is built through diversity, redundancy, and the ability to adapt when conditions change.

These structural improvements cannot eliminate every disruption, but they can reduce the ability of competitors to weaponize America’s supply chains. Once those vulnerabilities are addressed, the focus shifts from identifying the risks to determining how households, investors, businesses, and policymakers should respond.



Attention: Strategic resilience depends on reducing dependence—whether on a foreign processor, a single supplier, or an overly concentrated domestic market—before those vulnerabilities become instruments of economic coercion.

3. Preparing for a Long-Term Economic Conflict: Personal and National Strategies for Resilience, Investment, and Food Security

If the vulnerabilities in America's food system are structural, then the response must be structural as well. Strategic resilience is not built by predicting the next disruption, but by reducing dependence on fragile supply chains before the next disruption occurs.

At the national level, that means expanding competitive domestic capacity in fertilizer production, chemical processing, refining, and natural gas. It means diversifying imports among trusted allies rather than relying on any single supplier for essential agricultural inputs. It means strengthening the physical infrastructure that keeps food moving—railroads, ports, barges, pipelines, storage facilities, and irrigation systems—and accelerating responsible permitting so that projects measured in decades can begin addressing challenges measured in months. Carefully designed, sunset-dated strategic inventories of critical nutrients and sulfur can also provide temporary resilience without becoming permanent government programs.

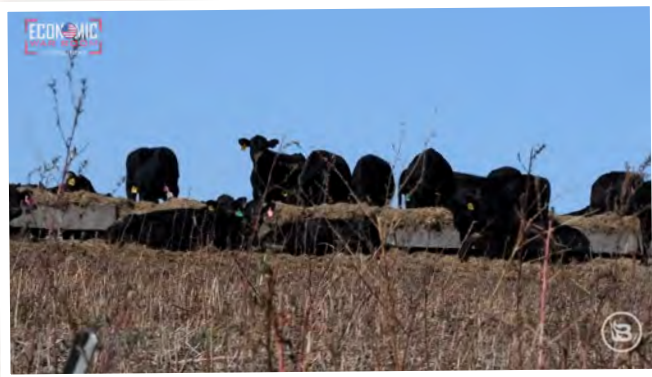
Equally important is recognizing what doesn't solve the problem. Price controls do not create more fertilizer. Permanent subsidies do not eliminate structural shortages. Long-term resilience comes from expanding capacity, increasing competition, and restoring redundancy throughout the supply chain.

The same principle applies at the household level.

Preparation is not about fear; it is about preserving the freedom to make thoughtful decisions when disruptions occur. A practical, rotating thirty-day pantry of foods your family

already eats—rice, beans, oats, canned proteins, cooking oil, salt, coffee, and other staples—is not an extreme measure. It simply creates time. Backup plans for refrigeration, cooking, and water provide additional flexibility during temporary outages. Relationships with local farmers, ranchers, churches, and community organizations restore the local resilience that decades of just-in-time supply chains gradually eliminated.



Investment strategy follows the same logic. Rather than chasing temporary commodity price spikes, investors should examine the infrastructure that supports the entire food system: natural gas production, fertilizer manufacturing, farm equipment, irrigation, grain storage, cold-chain logistics, railroads, ports, barges, and domestic processing capacity. These businesses may not generate headlines

during every market cycle, but they often represent durable assets positioned to benefit from long-term structural demand.

Ultimately, this conversation is about stewardship rather than speculation. Throughout history, societies that prepared during periods of abundance were better positioned to endure periods of disruption. Preparation should never become panic, nor should stewardship become hoarding. The goal is to build enough resilience to care not only for your own household but also for your community when unexpected challenges arise.

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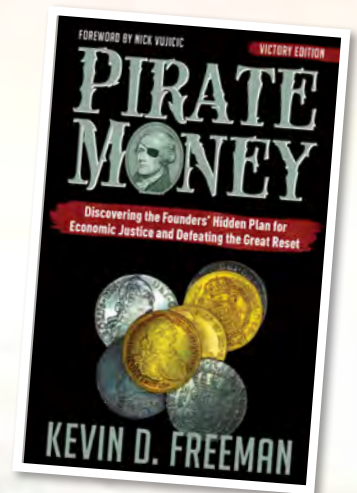

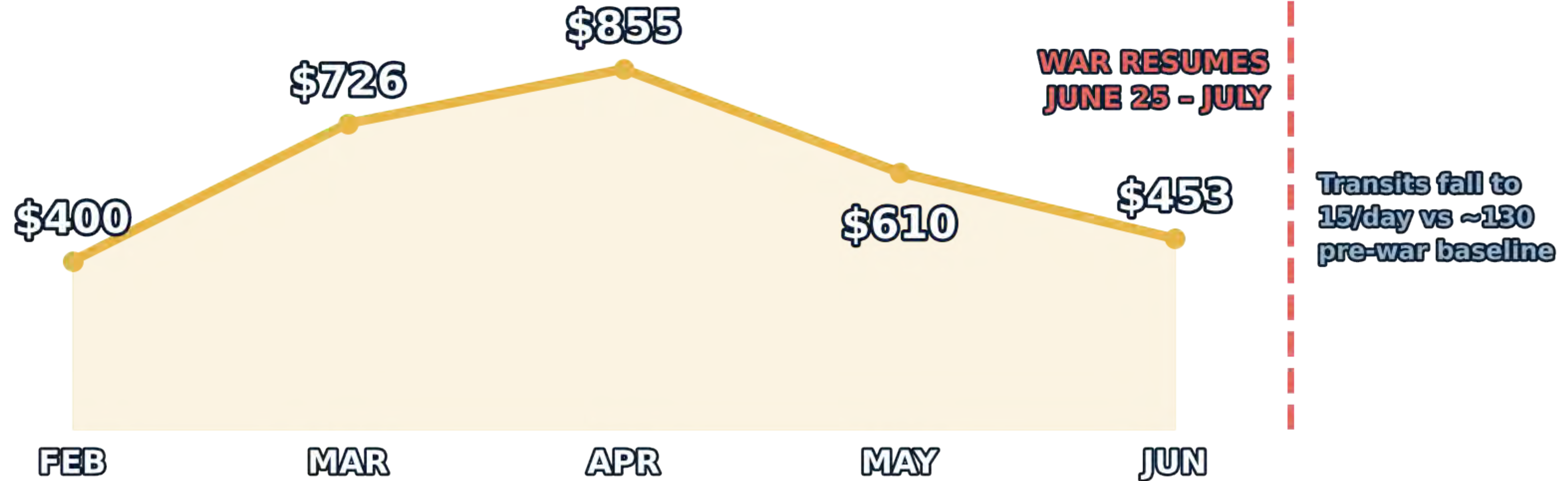

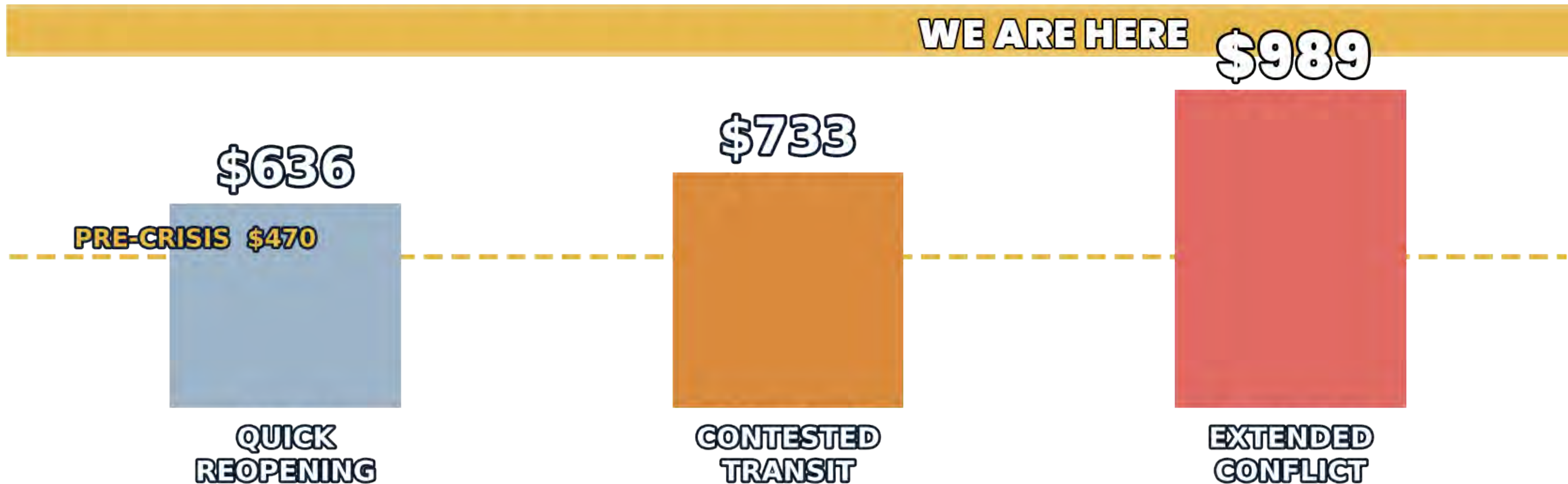
